Polish Movie – Playground (Shortlisted in world competition section)

Speakers – Bartosz Kowalski, Director and Mirella Zaradkiewicz, Producer

- Speaking on the occasion, Bartosz said, “This film is based on a real life story and I came across to that story accidentally, but the story was so deep that it impacted me, moved me. I haven’t glorified any violence in this film but screened what I could feel”
- We used ‘Fear’ as a creative element in this film. Though one may not have any logical explanation to why and how evils are born, if their violence scares you I believe it’s cinematic enough.
- Casting was the most difficult part of this film. We audited thousands of children, spent months on it. However finally we got 3 talented kids who had something in them that eased their presence on the screen.
- The movie was not accepted by the crowds since only few believed that such things can happen in real life.
- The film industry scenario in Poland is now changing, many young people are coming to this field and are making top class films.

Marathi Movie – Ventilator (Shortlisted in Marathi competition section)

Speakers – Rajesh Mapuskar, Writer and Director, Jitendra Joshi, Actor, Satish Alekar, Actor

- “Music has played an important part in my life. It has impacted my writing in a significant manner. It helps me to understand the mood of the story which makes it easier for me to articulate it” mentioned Rajesh Mapuskar speaking on the occasion.
